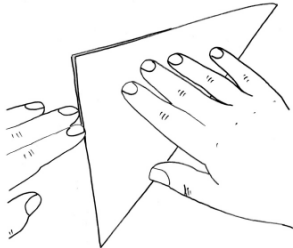
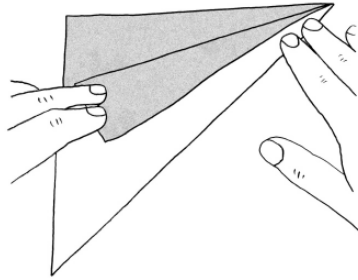


Penguin

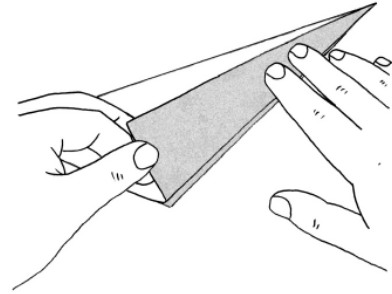
This little fellow is made from a square which is white on one side and coloured on the other.



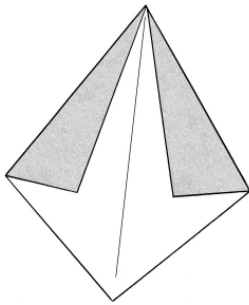
1. Start with the paper colour side up and fold it point to point across the diagonal as shown.



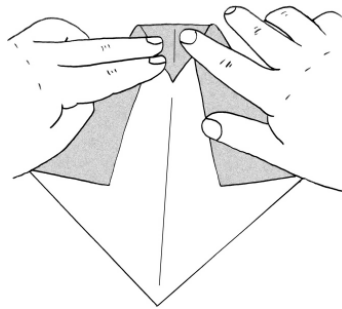
2. Fold back one layer about two thirds towards middle the crease making a point at the top corner.



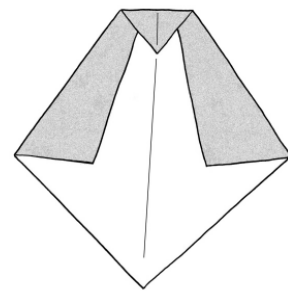
3. Turn the paper over and do the same on the other side. Press down well for good creases.



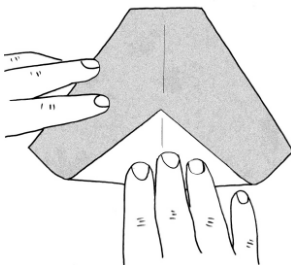
4. Open out the centre fold and you should have this shape.



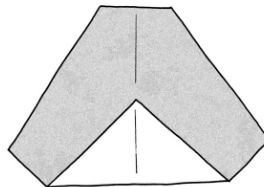
5. Fold the top point down a little to make the head.



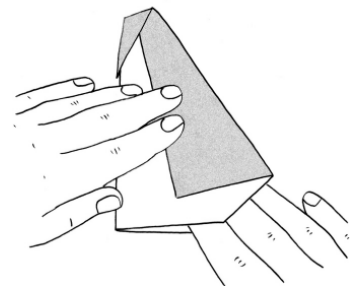
6. This is what it should look like.



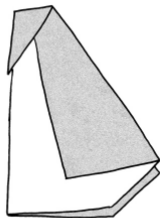
7. Turn the paper over and fold the bottom point up the centre crease.



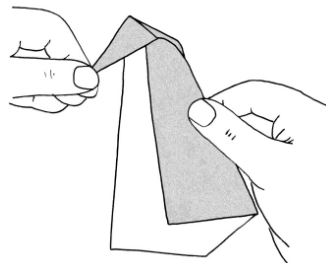
8. It should now look like this.



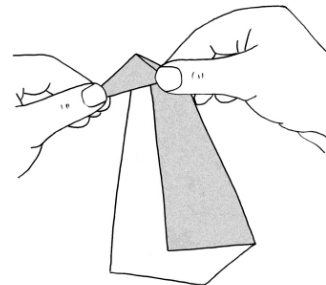
9. Fold the left hand side of the penguin over the right using the centre line as a guide.



10. Press all the creases in well.



11. Holding the back of the penguin, lift the head up to the desired position.



Complete the penguin by pressing down a new crease to make the head stay in place.
